Ending Your Tenancy: Leaving your home in good condition

If you decide you want to leave your home, you must make sure you leave it clear and in good condition.

This leaflet will explain what you need to do before you move.



Leaving your home

We hope you have enjoyed living in your home. Before you move on we need to remind you about a few things you need to do to make sure your home is left clear and in a good condition.

Moving to another Platform home?

If you have applied for another of our homes, your Platform Officer will make an appointment to come and visit your home to check all is well for you to move. Please keep to the agreed appointment time so we can make the move as quick and easy as possible.

Here's what your Platform Officer will do:

- Check your home and garden/grounds meet our agreed standard.
- Advise you of their findings. If your home fails to meet the standard, they will explain why.

Failure to meet the required standard will result in your new housing application being unsuccessful.

Making the move easier – your checklist

Before you end your tenancy here are a few things for you to check. To help make moving out easier, we've included a handy checklist below to ensure your home is left clean and ready for the next customer.

Please remember: if your home does not meet the standards outlined, we will ask you to pay the costs of carrying out any necessary work.

Inside your home	
Please remember:	Have you checked this?
Furniture, appliances and goods must be removed.	\bigcirc
All fitted cupboards and kitchen units must be clean and empty.	\bigcirc
To clear the loft of all your belongings.	\bigcirc
Any electrical fittings you have put in must be removed by a qualified electrician and either made safe or the original fittings replaced. Eg: chandeliers, brass/chrome light switches. Please leave all light bulbs in place.	\bigcirc
Any damage to doors, windows, walls, banisters, kitchen units etc. which is not 'fair wear and tear' must be repaired.	\bigcirc
Walls and ceilings should be of a neutral colour finish, with all cracks filled in.	\bigcirc
Your home should be clean throughout.	\bigcirc
Any repairs that are your responsibility need to be done.	\bigcirc
Curtains, blinds, carpets and other floor coverings you have fitted must be removed, unless you have discussed this with your Platform Officer and have completed a Gifting Form.	\bigcirc
Leave operating instructions for equipment (boiler, gas fire etc.) all in one place.	\bigcirc
To pay all utility bills up to the date your tenancy ends.	\bigcirc
To leave the smart meter remote unit in the home, if applicable.	\bigcirc
All door and window keys are to be left as instructed by your Platform Officer when you leave.	\bigcirc

Outside	your	home
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Please remember:	Have you checked this?
All grass and hedges and shrubs must be cut/pruned back.	\bigcirc
Gardens must be cleared of rubbish and personal items.	\bigcirc
Fences and gates must be in sound condition and any damage repaired.	\bigcirc
To make sure you have cleaned up after your pets.	\bigcirc
To have any external electrics you have fitted removed and made safe by a qualified electrician.	\bigcirc
To empty the wheelie bin, and leave it in place for the new tenant.	\bigcirc
To remove compost heaps, compost containers etc.	\bigcirc
All sheds and outbuildings owned by Platform must be totally emptied and cleaned out.	\bigcirc
All sheds, greenhouses and other outbuildings that you own must be fully emptied and removed unless you have completed a gifting form with your Platform Officer - they must still be emptied fully.	\bigcirc
To empty and fill in any garden ponds, that you have installed, and return the area to its pre-pond condition.	\bigcirc



Alterations you have made		
Please remember:	Have you checked this?	
If you had our written permission to make an alteration (through our Permission Application process) and your Platform Officer feels its condition, suitability and health and safety give NO CAUSE FOR CONCERN , you can leave it in place.	\bigcirc	
If you have made any alterations WITHOUT our written permission you will need to return them to their original condition. In some cases your Platform Officer may be able to give able to give you written permission for the alteration to stay in place.	\bigcirc	

Bulky items	
Please remember:	Have you checked this?
If you have any unwanted bulky items, please make sure they are moved. Visit your local council website to find out more or give them a call for more information.	\bigcirc
For items of furniture and household appliances in good condition, please call the British Heart Foundation on 0808 250 0240 or visit their website at www.bhf.org.uk to arrange a free collection.	\bigcirc

There will be a 15% administration charge added to any recharge costs.
